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Meet rules and information

The Meet

1. The Meet promoter is Anna Jex on behalf of the Committee of the City of St Albans Amateur Swimming Club. The event will be held at the Westminster Lodge Leisure Centre, St Albans AL1 2DL on Sunday 26 March 2017.
2. The competition is to be held under ASA laws and ASA technical rules of racing and the ASA Open Meet Licensing Criteria and is licensed by the ASA as a **LEVEL 3** meet.
3. Entrants must be ASA Registered at Category 2 and belong to an affiliated club.
4. The meet offers all strokes at 50m, 100m as well as 200m freestyle and 200 IM.
5. There are no lower entry standards so entries with 'No Time' are permissible. Upper qualifying times are attached as and no swimmers may enter those events for which they have swum faster than the upper standard for that event.
6. Entry times if used can be long course times converted to short course.
7. Clubs entering more than 4 swimmers must do so electronically by using Hy-Tek 'Team Manager Lite'. This can be downloaded from <http://www.hy-tek ltd.com/downloads.html> after which you can enter your swimmer details and times into the programme to create an entries file and then e-mail your file to clubevents@costsaasc.org for inclusion in the meet. You can then send in your TM entry file with a complete summary sheet and payment.
8. Entries of 4 or fewer swimmers can be accepted by Hy-Tek TM files or on the manual entry form along with a summary sheet.
9. Entry forms and Team Manager files must be received by the promoter on or before the specified closing date of 15 February 2017 and be fully and correctly completed. Payment should be made when the files are sent.
10. Entries which do not follow the above procedures may be rejected.
11. Entry fees will be £5.50 per event.
12. Members of CoStA should enter through the club website, by the closing date published.
13. Entries will be restricted to ensure the meet runs to time. If the event is oversubscribed the promoter reserves the right to return entries. Entries will be processed in the order in which they are received and so the meet is a "first come first served" meet. The promoter's decision is final.
14. Entry Summary Forms can be posted to the address shown, but preferably should be scanned and emailed.
15. Refunds will be made on medical grounds only (supported by a Doctor's note).
16. If, at the closing date, the meet still has capacity to accept more swimmers, we may re-open the meet and accept further entries on a first come, first served basis until we reach capacity. This will be advertised on the club website. Entries accepted after the closing date will be for time trial swims i.e. no medals will be awarded.
17. No time trial or exhibition swims will be offered on the day of the meet.

The Events

18. Over the top starts will be used in the heats if required by the referee.
19. Heats will be swum as mixed age with swimmers seeded by entry times.
20. Age groups for boys and girls are: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 & over years.
21. Ages are as at the date of the meet, which is 26 March 2017.

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22. All events are timed finals. Awards will be made to the top 3 swimmers in each event in each age category.
23. The pool length is 25m, has anti-wave ropes and it is intended that the middle 8 lanes of 10 will be used. AOE will be used for the meet.
24. The depth of the water is variable but will be set to 2m for the competition.
25. Session timings may be adjusted depending on the number of entries received and accepted. Any changes will be posted on the City of St Albans Swimming Club website at www.costaasc.org
26. A list of accepted entries & rejections will be posted on our website and will be emailed to the contact for each club.
27. Swimmers will be required to sign in for each session to confirm the events they wish to swim. Sign in times will be posted on www.costaasc.org.
28. Results will available at the venue on the day, will be posted on the club website at the end of weekend, and will be supplied to British Swimming for entry into the national ranking database.

Passes & Payments

29. Coaches' passes will be available for £10 per pass (maximum of 3 per club). It is the responsibility of the entered club to ensure that the coaches they have on poolside are fully compliant with ASA Guidelines for Child Protection. In accordance with ASA Guidelines for Child Protection, Coach Passes cannot be purchased on the day of the meet.
30. Passes can only be obtained by completing the meet summary form with named persons/coaches and submitting it to the Promoter. Passes must be displayed at all times. Passes entitle the coach to refreshments/food between sessions, access to pool side, plus copies of all relevant meet information on the day.
31. Clubs should make their entries collectively and send payment via electronic banking (details enclosed on Summary Sheet) or alternatively by cheque – 1 per club only (make cheques payable to '**City of St Albans Swimming Club**'). Any refund cheques will only be payable to the entered Club.
32. No coaches or team managers will be allowed on poolside without a pass.

General

33. By submitting an entry form or TM entry, Clubs, Competitors and Coaches are agreeing to be bound by these rules.
34. Entries to this meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoters.
35. Swimmers will not be allowed into the viewing gallery in swimming costumes and footwear must be worn outside of the pool area. All swimmers and spectators should comply with the safety requirements of Westminster Lodge.
36. Only swimmers and team managers, coaches and officials will be allowed on poolside.
37. Any event support volunteers must be registered with the Event Lead on the day and should be wearing a name label. Any non-swimmers on poolside not registered or wearing a label will be asked to leave the area.
38. No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to clothing or other articles.
39. All swimmers should be supervised by their coaches/team managers during warm up and whilst on poolside. Coaches and team managers are responsible for the behaviour of their swimmers at all times. The poolside area must be left clean and tidy with all litter removed.

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40. Photography: Westminster Lodge leisure centre requires anyone on poolside who wishes to take photographs has a permit from the Duty Manager. A form is available by contacting the Meet Promoter. Their rules require that:

Where feasible restrict your images to capturing only those identified on the form.

- *Please be sensitive to the feelings, beliefs and considerations of other customers, especially parents and children when taking photographs. If other customers make it clear that they do not wish to be photographed, please respect their wishes*
- *Filming and Photography is not permitted in any of the following areas:*
 - *changing rooms*
 - *showers*
 - *toilet areas*
- *In the event of any query please speak immediately to the Duty Manager*
- *We reserve the right to access the images taken on site.*

The rules on photography apply to swimmers, coaches, team managers, officials and volunteers as well as spectators, and to the use of mobile phones, tablets or other image-capturing electronic devices as well as cameras. Note that any photography in the changing rooms is absolutely forbidden by both the club and the swimming pool management.

41. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to ASA Laws, Regulations and the ASA Technical Rules of Racing.
